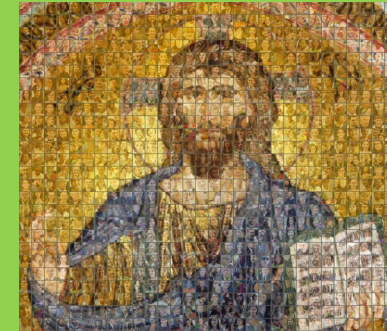

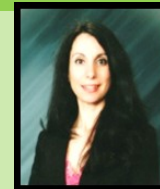

Conference Keynotes



Dr. Josephine Lombardi has worked in a variety of ministries. Currently, she is Associate Professor of Pastoral and Systematic Theology, Professor of Field Education, and Director of Lay Formation at St. Augustine's Seminary in Scarborough, Ontario. She is an author, retreat leader, and has presented at numerous conferences. She has worked in radio and television and hosts a weekly radio show on the New Evangelization. She was a frequent guest on CTV National News during the 2013 Papal Conclave. Her book *On Earth as it is in Heaven*, published by Novalis has been well received and featured on Salt and Light Television.

Fr. Eugene (Red) O'Reilly, C.Ss.R., affectionately known as "Red", was born in Monaghan, Ireland in 1944. He came to Canada with his family and later joined the Redemptorists. After a B.A. from the University of Windsor, he pursued theological studies in France and Montreal. Ordained in 1972, he began preaching missions and retreats in 1983 to parishes, teachers, school boards, clergy and Religious throughout Canada and the United States. He has also served in St. John's, Newfoundland as Pastor of a large parish. He has been Vocation Director for the Redemptorists in the Eastern Province. Father Red completed a sabbatical year, part of which was spent at the School of Applied Theology, Berkley, California. He has a particular interest in music, and has composed a number of religious songs, some in the Catholic Book of Worship. He has teamed up with other Redemptorists, and they have produced four recordings.

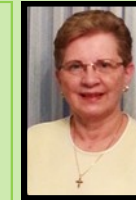

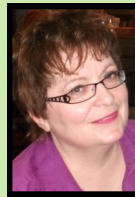
